Dear Sirs,

This is to inform that Amendment no.1 dated February 1, 2008 stands superceded. The terms and conditions of the IFB as detailed below stand amended. **Bidders in their own interest are requested to check our website <http://www.hsccltd.co.in> regularly for any further amendments/information.**

**A. Clause 1.1 (g) , Section-II, General conditions of contract at page 14 is substituted as under: -**

**1. DEFINITIONS**

1.1(g) "Consignee" means any location as specified by NICD. The supplier shall initially deliver the equipment to National Institute of Communicable Diseases, New Delhi, where the equipment shall be stockpiled. Thereafter ,the equipments shall be shifted, installed, commissioned and tested by the Supplier at his own cost to different States/ Districts within the Country ensuring the quickest mode of transport for urgent installation as per the directions of NICD

**B. Clause 10 Section-II, General conditions of contract at page 16 is substituted as under :-**

**10. INSURANCE**

10.58 The Goods supplied under the contract shall be fully insured including transit insurance against various risks as required or approved by the Purchaser arising out of transportation, storage, delivery, erection, installation, testing and commissioning at his cost up to installation at the Consignee.

10.59 The insurance shall be obtained by the supplier in an amount equal to 110% of the value of the goods from "Ware house to ware house" (final destination) on "all risks" basis including war, risks, strikes, erection, storage etc. In any event the Goods are at the suppliers risk until installation at the Consignee.

- 10.57 The Supplier shall also be responsible for any damage to the equipment during transportation from NICD to the consignee. In the event of any damage to the goods, the supplier shall be responsible for making claims from the Insurance agency and replace the equipment.

**C. Clause 12 Section-II, General conditions of contract at page 17 is substituted as under :-**

**12. PAYMENT:**

For Both Indian origin goods and goods of imported origin. To be read in conjunction with clause 6.0 of ITB.

- 12.19 The Supplier's request (s) for payment shall be made to the Purchaser in writing, accompanied by an invoice describing as appropriate, the inspection certificate as per clause 27, the Goods delivered and Services performed and by document submitted and upon fulfilment of other obligations stipulated in the Contract . The payment can be released through confirmed and irrevocable Letter of Credit (LC) in favour of the supplier.

- 12.2(a) 80% of the invoice value will be made within 30 days of documentary proof of receipt of the invoiced goods along with necessary documents like consignee Receipt Certificate, Inspection Certificate, transport, transit insurance etc.


In case of payment through Letter of Credit, Eighty(80) percent of invoice value will be made within 30 days of documentary proof of receipt of the invoiced goods alongwith necessary documents like Consignee Receipt Certificate, Inspection Certificate, transport, transit insurance and documentary proof like Bill of Entry, LC Documents etc., that the equipment has been imported from foreign principal.

- 12.2(b) Balance 20% payment subjected to clause 6.1 of ITB will be released within 30 days , upon receipt of satisfactory Installation & Commissioning Certificate from Consignees on pro-rata basis on submission of the Bank Guarantee of the total amount due on installation, i.e. 20% payment, valid till completion of installation Upon receipt of satisfactory Installation & Commissioning Certificate from all the consignees, i.e. for the total ordered quantity, the Bank Guarantee shall be released.

In case of equipment stockpiled at NICD, it is appropriate to mention that if the consignee list could not be provided and the equipment is consequently not installed within 18 months from the date of delivery, then the warranty shall start after 18 months from the date of delivery and the balance payment due to the supplier can be released against Bank Guarantee.

All other terms and conditions of the above referred IFB remain unchanged.
